or many, February is a time when Black history is showcased and celebrated, but for singer/musician Avery\*Sunshine, this month has shaped up to be one where she makes history.

She kicked things off by earning — alongside her musical partner in crime/husband Dana Johnson — her first-ever Grammy award (for her album, So Glad to Know You).

And she's wrapping up the month by headlining a special, four-night residency at CityWinery Atlanta (February 23-26).

Of course, triumphs like this aren't new to this legend in the making. Here's a rundownof a few more milestones she, and several of her other talented collaborators, have marked over the years:



Besides So Glad to Know You, her discography includes beloved albums like the self-titled Avery\*Sunshine, The SunRoom, Twenty Sixty Four and Four Songs & A Bootleg, as well as remixes by heavy-hitting producers such as Terry Hunter and Atlanta's own Salah Ananse, among others.





Renowned for her soul-stirring performances, she's taken the stage for unforgettable live shows in Japan, on the U.K.'s award-winning Jools Holland Show, an episode of NPR's Tiny Desk Concert and many more.

**Ebenezer Baptist Church** 

Her roots lie in the church: She served as a member of the groundbreaking gospel/soul duo DaisyRew and as musical director of the iconic Ebenezer Baptist Church in Atlanta.

In addition to creating award-winning music, she is also the creator of Lou\*Mack Beauty - a cosmetic company founded to "encourage women of color to discover, connect to and celebrate the beauty of our lineage." \*
